

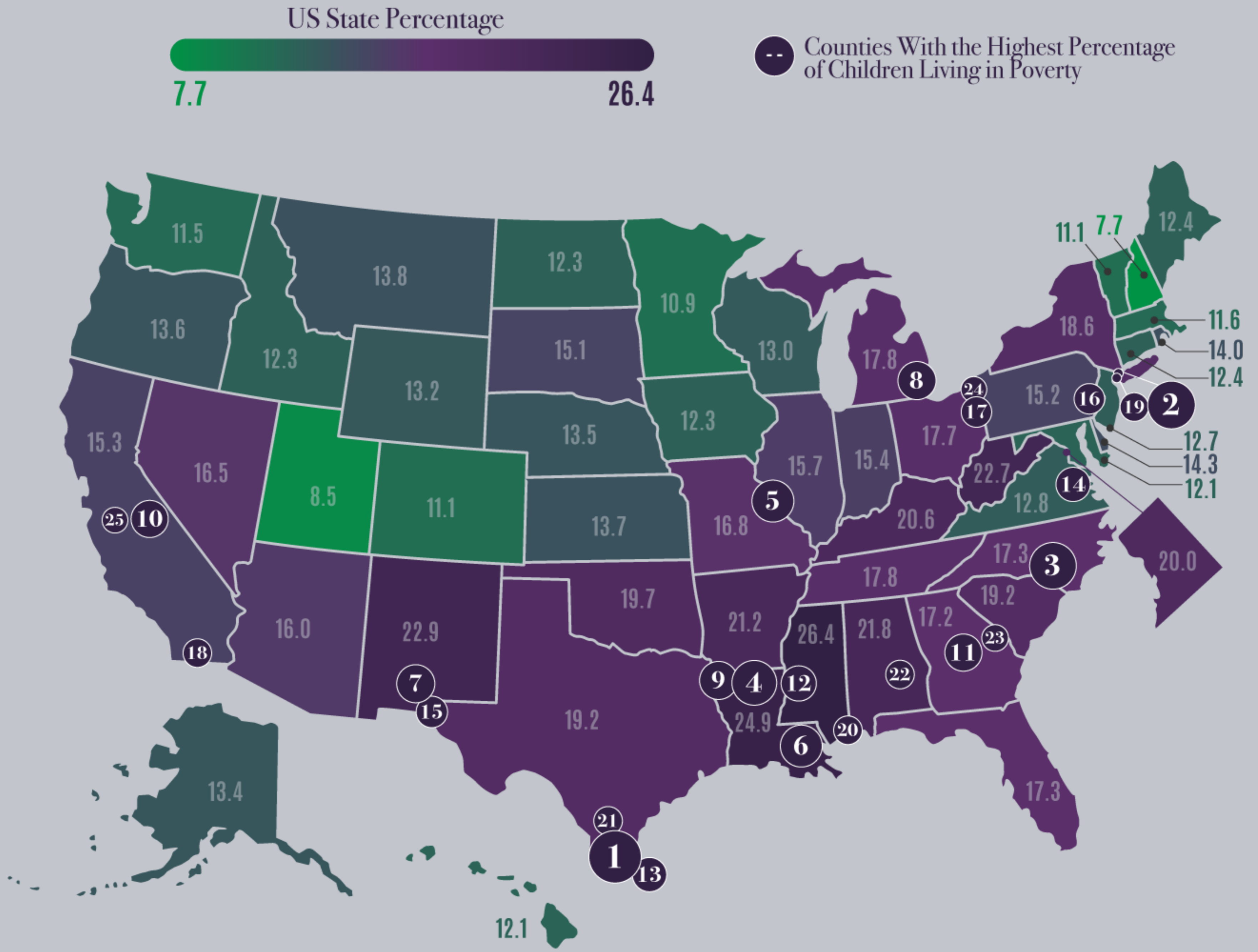
THE 25 U.S. COUNTIES WHERE THE MOST CHILDREN ARE LIVING IN POVERTY
